Since 2003, Thursday's Child has funded six evening meals per year for parents of seriously ill children who are patients at American Family Children's Hospital in

Madison. Each meal serves 50-60 people. A meal at the end of a stressful and exhausting day is appreciated by parents who want and need to stay close to their child's bedside. Thursday's Child's annual contribution is \$3,000.

On our **Santa List** this year were 90 families--a list provided by their social workers at American Family Children's Hospital. A \$50 Target gift card is provided for each child in the family, with a maximum of four cards per family. We've received many thank you notes already this year. Here are some samples:
